Characteristics

pink flowers, can grow to 8'

giant blue grass

usually shaped into a rounded ball 2-3'

low growing shrub with white fragrant flowers

open growth to 5-6' with red-orange berries

mounding growth with mainly blue flowers

low growing with yellow daisy like flowers

large succulent, several varieties

four different varieties, can grow to 3-4'

purple foliage, pink flowers, grows to 4-5'

large purple spikes, can grow to 6' but needs to be cut back every season

grows to 4-6' with deep pink flowers

shrub to 3-4', long purple spikes

Many varieties, shrub to 3-4' , long tan fuzzy flower spikes

small shrub with small evergreen shiny leaves

grows to 7-10' with violet, lavender and white flowers, but generally smaller

Pink or white flowers on long thin spikes

native ornamental grass, grows to 2-3 '

Perennial plant that produces either white, pink or yellow flowers. Grows to 18'
